

PAINT POLYMER NO. 100

Use this product as a binding agent in a paint mixture, for use on polyethylene mulch to give temporary whitening for up to 8 weeks.

INGREDIENTS:

Acrylic Copolymer 53.00%

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

MIXING AND APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

1. Fill spray tank 3/4 full with water.
2. Add SA-50 Surfactant for Herbicides.
3. Add SA-50 Defoamer.
4. With full mechanical agitation running, slowly add clay.
5. After clay is well dispersed and thoroughly suspended, add Paint Polymer No. 100.
6. Add remaining water to fill tank.
7. Leave agitation on at all times until empty.
8. **SPRAYING SUGGESTIONS:**
Use 2 or 3 large fan nozzles over bed area (#8006 or #8008).
Use fairly low pressure, 50-75 psi.

Wash and flush sprayer immediately after use with surfactant and water.

Surfactant for Herbicides	1 pint
Defoamer	1 ounce
Continental Clay	100 lbs.
Paint Polymer No. 100	2 gallons

COVERAGE: Individual preferences as to color density will greatly effect coverage. Under average conditions 100 gallons of paint mixture will cover 3 to 6 rolls of plastic mulch 2,400 feet long and 3 feet wide.

NOTE: Keep from Freezing. DO NOT STORE THIS PRODUCT BELOW 34°F.
